## REACH Compliance Statement

(Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals)

Advanced Interconnections Corp. (AIC) is a producer of articles for sale under the European Union's REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006. These articles may be exported directly to the European Union or they may eventually be included in other products exported to the European Union. All active products manufactured by Advanced Interconnections Corp. (articles and all packaging materials for these articles) comply with REACH regulations and meet the restrictions described under REACH Annex XVII.

The Regulation exempts producers from certain substance reporting obligations, where they can exclude exposure of the substance to humans or the environment during normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. In addition, the recent European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) Response to Comments on the SVHC Proposal for the Eventual Inclusion of Lead in Annex XIV explicitly states that the inclusion of lead (Pb) on the SVHC list does not intend a general ban on lead in products at this time.

Many of the products manufactured and sold by AIC contain components made of a copper alloy (brass). Copper alloy contains lead. RoHS exemption 6C currently allows for lead (Pb), CAS 7439-92-1 of up to 4% by weight. AIC testing is not performed for materials and substances that were not intentionally added. No warranty, liability of indemnification is expressed or implied with this information.
